

This week, I participated in one of our national (Atlantic branch) charity fundraising activities for a cause close to our heart. Prostate Cancer Canada (PCC) held its annual Wake Up Breakfast (for information on the event: [click here](#)) in Moncton, NB. The event was very well attended, hosted by Aldéa Landry, moderated by [Mr. Peter Mallette](#), PCC Atlantic Executive Director and Dr. Rodney Ouellette, raising \$68,000.. Half the profit will be invested in research at ACRI. A similar event took place in Saint John, NB in September with the participation of the SJRH-Foundation. Our health charities play a key role in building capacity in our province. Most have national research programs (PCC, CCS, ASC, HSFC, etc.) but we, as a province, have been not been successful in capturing significant funding from those programs.
