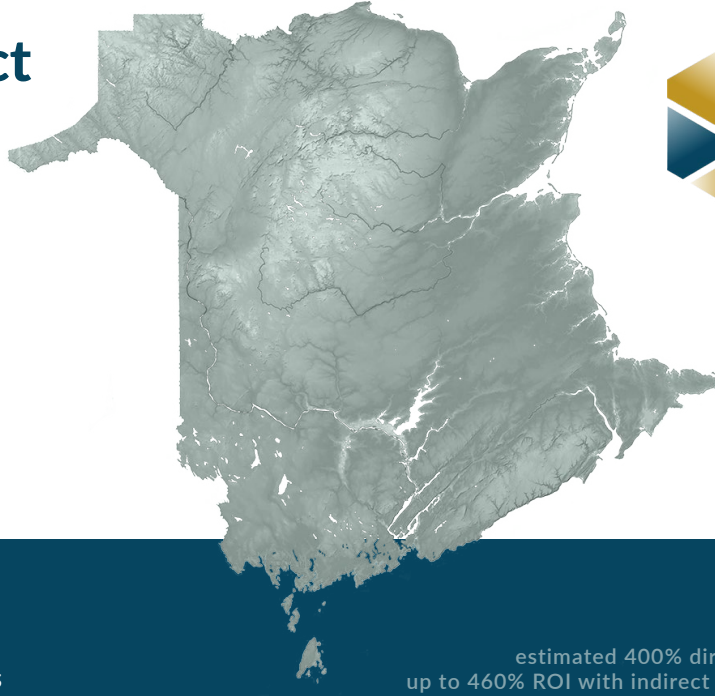

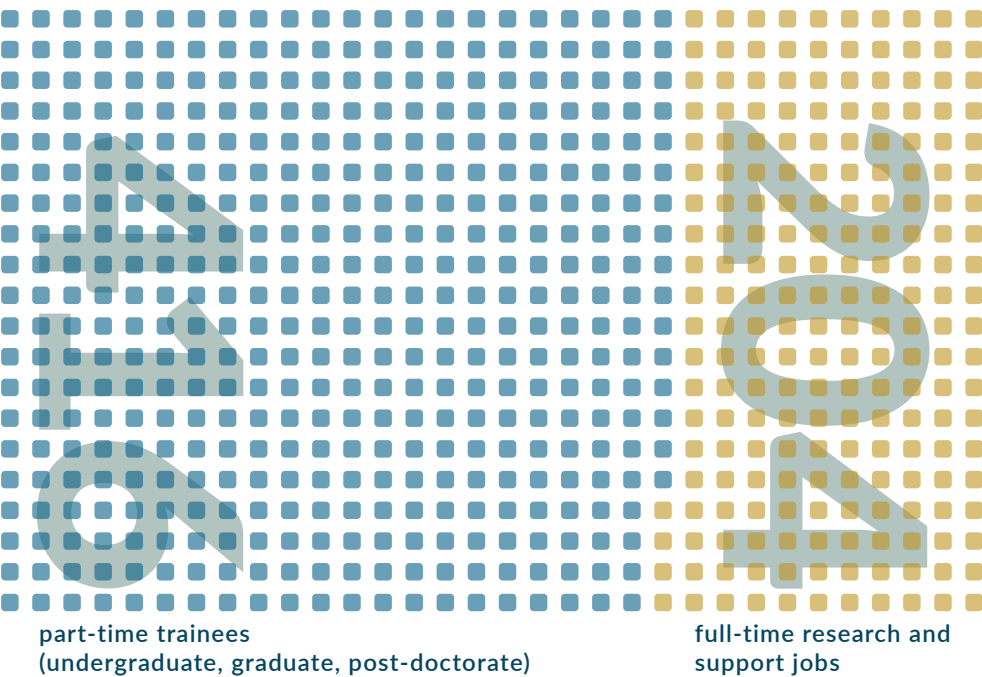
\$1 of net government spend in NBHRF provides

average overall New Brunswick health research funding: \$20 million annually
